Transitional Communities

1. Our Home - “Nosso Lar”

- ✓ Situated above the lower zones and below the higher regions
- ✓ Evolutionary homogeneity of the inhabitants
- ✓ Beauty and harmony in Nature
- ✓ Divided in six Ministries
- ✓ Essentially a work colony

Transitional Communities

2. Castrel's City - "Cidade de Castrel"

A spiritual colony organized to attend to Spirits that disincarnated in infancy and to prepare others for reincarnation.

Transitional Communities

3. Blessing's Home – “Lar da Bênção”

- ✓ Important educational colony
- ✓ Situated in the spiritual plane of Brazilian territories
- ✓ Prepare mothers for a responsible maternity
- ✓ Attend to Spirits that disincarnated in infancy

Aid Stations – Outposts

1. Peace’s Mansion – “Mansão da Paz”

Institution of spiritual readjustment maintained by the “Nosso Lar” colony.

Aid Stations – Outposts

2. Peace's Camp – “Campo da Paz”

- ✓ Located in the midst of the lower zone
- ✓ Receive sick Spirits, shaken by the shock of physical death, by the attachment of persons and assets left behind in the physical plane.
- ✓ After readjustment, they are lead to other planes or to reincarnation
