The spirit's name isn't important; it's quite possible that no one on earth knows that name. This is why we refer to it as "Guardian Angel" or "Good Spirit". We could even call it using the name of some higher spirit who has inspired in us special ties of affection.

#### Item 14 Prayer:

Beloved spirits and guardian angels, sent by an infinitely merciful God to assist all humanity, be our protectors during all life's trials! Give us the strength, the courage, the fortitude we need. Inspire us to follow after everything good, and keep us from going down the incline that leads to evil. May your sweet influence fill our souls. Make us feel that we have by our side devoted friends who care about our suffering and take part in our joys.

And you, my Good Angel, never leave me alone. I need all of your protection to be able to support the trials appointed by Providence with faith and love.

"Yes, and contrary to what they believe, earthlings are far from being first in intelligence, goodness and perfection. God has populated all worlds with living beings who all work toward the final objective of Providence. To believe that living beings are limiting only to their own particular spot in the universe is to doubt the wisdom of God, who has never made anything without a purpose, and who must have intended these worlds to fulfill a more important role than simply entertaining our eyes. Moreover, there is nothing in the earth's position, volume or composition that could reasonably support the notion that to the exclusion of many thousands of similar worlds it alone has the privilege of being inhabited.
