Among the fluids and energies that come from the Universal Fluid there is the vital fluid, considered

> "(...) The principle of material and organic life, whatever its source, and which is common to all living things, from plants to human beings."

This fluid also called in the past as nervous fluid is magnetic in nature and can be transmitted from one individual to another through passes, according to the spiritist nomenclature.



1. Concept of Spiritist Passes



Passes as applied in the Spiritist Center, are not restricted to simple transmission of magnetic energy coming from the vital fluid of the Incarnate donor.

It involves the transfusion of mixed energy, magnetic-spiritual, originating respectively from the incarnate worker and the discarnates that collaborate in this kind of spiritist activity.





Passes are a transfusion of energies that alter the cellular field.

2. Types of energy transmitted in the pass



1st By the fluid of the magnetizer himself; properly speaking, magnetism, or human magnetism, the action of which is subordinate to the power, and above all to the quality of the fluid.

2nd By fluid from the spirit acting directly and without intermediation upon an incarnate being (...). That is spiritual magnetism, of which the quality is determined by the quality of the spirit.





3rd By the fluid which the spirits shed upon the magnetizer, to which the latter serves as a conductor. This is mixed magnetism, semispiritual, or human-spiritual. The spiritual fluid, combined with the physical, gives to the latter the qualities which are wanting to it.



3. Mechanisms of the pass



"The vital fluid may be transmitted from one individual to another. Those who have greater quantities of it can give it to those who have less, and in certain cases they can bring back a life on the verge of being extinguished.."

"These fluids acting upon the perispirit, the latter, in its turn, reacts upon the material organism with which it is in molecular contact. If the effluvia are of a good nature, the bodies receive a salutary impression; if bad, a painful One.." KARDEC, Allan. *Genesis*. Chap. XIV, it. 18.





The magnetic-spiritual energies of the pass are processed in the perispirit of the receiver, and through the centers of force or perispiritual vital centers they reach the nerve plexus of the physical body, distributing, then throughout the organs.



4. Centers of Force or Chakras



The spirit André Luiz point out that there are seven main perispiritual structures of electromagnetic nature, called Vital Centers or Centers of Force, and they "(...) govern billions of microscopic entities, all in the service of intelligence (...)."

5. Nerve Plexus

Nerve plexus, four in number, are located in the physical body.
They are organized structures in the form of a net.
We see, then, that the centers force or vital centers connect with the somatic vehicle through the nerve plexus.

6. The pass in the mediumship meeting



In certain circumstances, passes should be applied in the mediumship meetings.



Avoid any kind of exaggeration, such as to establish that all meeting participants will receive passes before or after the manifestation of spirits.



In specific conditions, when the communicant Spirit appears to be in great suffering or when the medium has difficulty to convey the thought, it is important to provide magnetic-spiritual energies that for sure will benefit both the medium and the discarnate.



In painful mediumistic manifestations, as it is the case with some suicide and obsessors, the application of pass is generally necessary.
