

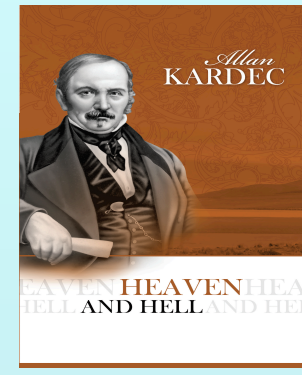

ANGELS



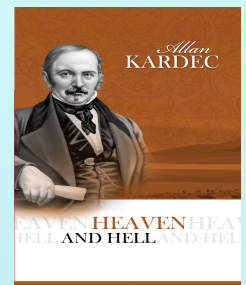
Angels are human souls who have attained the degree of perfection of perfection that beings are capable of, enjoying promised bliss in all its fullness.

According to Spiritism, demons are as-yet imperfect spirits who are susceptible to regeneration and although located at the bottom of the scale they will nevertheless ascend it.

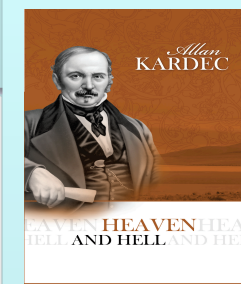

Where is heaven? Everywhere. No borders enclose it. Advanced worlds are the last stations leading to it; virtues facilitate the journey to it, while vices hinder access.

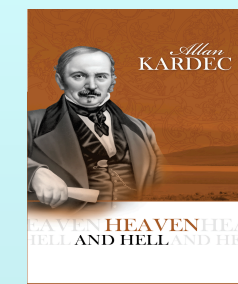
