# General Characteristics of Spiritual Communities

The spiritual world contains many regions or vibrational spheres, composed of evolutionary levels or planes, in which the Spirits group themselves in small, medium, or large cities, generically denominated *spiritual colonies*.

# General Characteristics of Spiritual Communities

The spiritual communities in the extra physical plane constitutes of Spirits that have similar aptitudes or tastes: the relationship amongst themselves establish the existence of “(...) different orders, according to the degree of purification to which they have attained.”

Therefore, the rules of life in society are established according to the degree of morality and knowledge of its inhabitants.

# General Characteristics of Spiritual Communities

“(...) the authority of spirits over one another, in virtue of their relative superiority, is very great, and gives to the higher ones a moral ascendancy over the lower ones which is absolutely irresistible.”

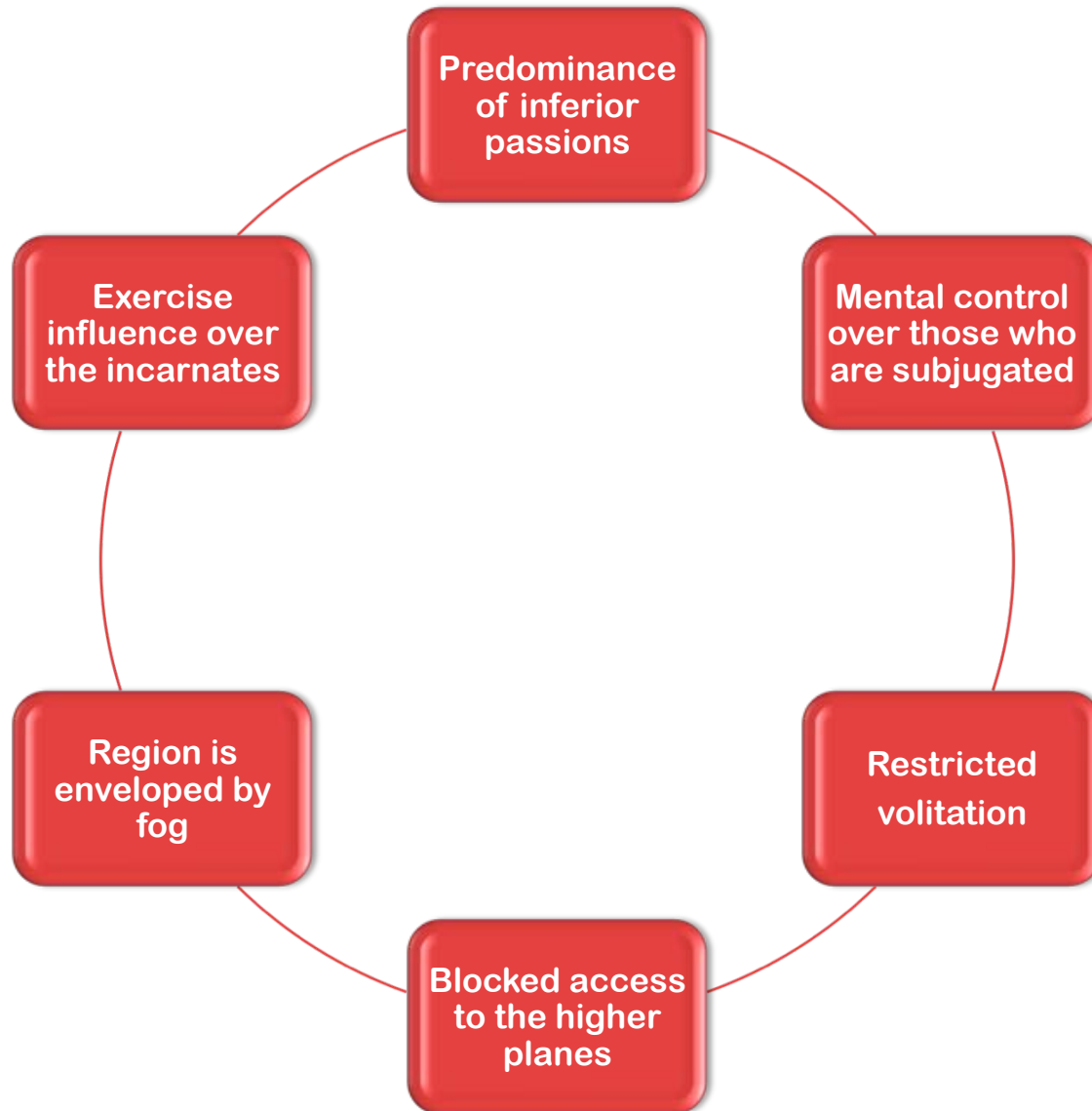
Between the higher level Spirits, this moral ascendancy is natural, always with a beneficent nature, with respect of each individual's free-will.

# General Characteristics of Spiritual Communities

These types of conditions, however, are not seen among inferior Spirits, who use intelligence or imposition on the will of others so they can be heard or, in certain circumstances, they can subjugate, ignoring that “(...) the absolute subjection of any person to another person is contrary to the law of God. Slavery is an abuse of strength; it disappears with progress, gradually, as all other abuses will disappear.
