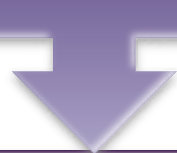

1. Fluids

They are substances that have the ability to expand; they are built from the primitive cosmic matter.

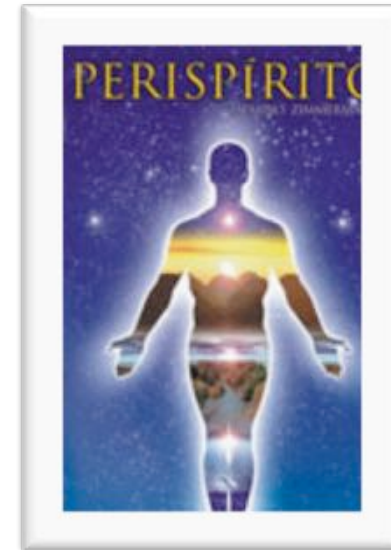
In the initial phase of mediumistic manifestation, the communicant Spirit envelops the medium in its own fluids.

After the fluidic envelopment, the second stage of mediumistic communication starts, and it is characterized by the perispiritual connection.

2. Perispirit


Defined as "(...) the fluidic body of the Spirits, it is one of the most important byproduct of the cosmic fluid. It is a condensation of this fluid around a focus of intelligence or soul."

The perispirit to perispirit interaction established between the communicant spirit and the medium, favors the multiplicity of mediumistic manifestations, defined by the mental connection of both of them.





3. Mind



Mind is a word that covers the set of "mental processes or mental activities of the individual."
